Note: Services were greatly impacted by Covid19, with much of our services moving to remote delivery in accordance with government guidelines through the whole of this reporting period.

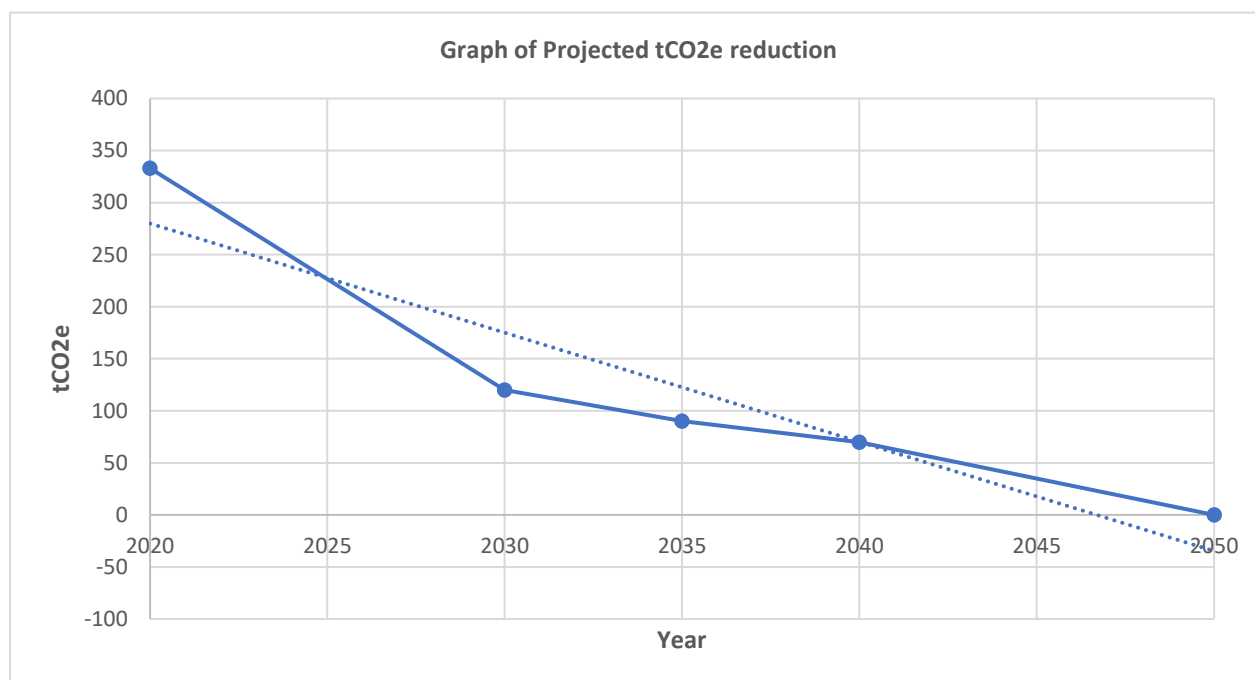

Emissions reduction targets

To continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to **150 tCO₂e** by 2027. This is a reduction of **50%**

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

This is our first carbon reduction plan. We do however have a detailed approach to sustainable development. During 2020, we introduced the use of Microsoft Teams (MS Teams) across our business. Its roll out was greatly accelerated due to the Covid-19 pandemic as we adapted to the government measures and continued operations. Whilst it is difficult to fully assess the full impact of the introductions of MS Teams with the restrictions that were in place during its first 12 months of operations, we have projected that its introduction reduced the volume of greenhouse gas emitted by 75 tonnes tCO₂e.

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

- Appointment of a senior manager to drive our approach to carbon reduction and sustainability practices.
- Development and implementation of a sustainable procurement policy that invests in products, materials and resources that are eco-friendly, sustainable and produced ethically.
- Aligning our environmental management systems in line with ISO14001:2015.
- Achievement of B Corp Certification (a social value and environmental management accreditation standard).
- Closer working with our landlords to support the implementation of energy saving devices within our delivery centres.
- Work with our supply chain partners to develop their approaches to carbon reduction and sustainability (Ingeus supply chain include delivery partners that provide either the same services as we do or, provide a service that supports our participant to progress towards their overarching target/goal).
- Review of staff commuting activities and introduction of salary sacrifice schemes to encourage them to utilise public transport/purchase of electric vehicles.

- Monitoring, measuring, and reporting environmental performance against policy objectives and KPIs.
- Continually improving the suitability, adequacy and effectiveness of Ingeus' environmental management systems to enhance its environmental performance.

Declaration and Sign Off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.

Emissions have been reported and recorded in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the GHG Reporting Protocol corporate standard¹ and uses the appropriate Government emission conversion factors for greenhouse gas company reporting².

Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions have been reported in accordance with SECR requirements, and the required subset of Scope 3 emissions have been reported in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Standard³.
